Today, it has grown into a strong and flourishing tree sheltering and shaping countless young minds and steadfastly pursuing the noble aim of imparting quality education. As we stand on the threshold of the glorious silver jubilee, it is my proud privilege to present the Annual Report of 2025-26. It is indeed a divinely bestowed opportunity to place before you a brief chronicle of our present achievements, milestones and progress.

The past year witnessed significant academic growth. Our students' relentless efforts yielded commendable results in internal and board examinations. Tailored remedial and enrichment programmes catered to diverse learning needs, empowering each student to reach their full potential.

BOARD EXAM RESULTS 2024-25

The academic year recorded exceptional achievements in the Board Examinations, with Class X and XII students attaining an excellent overall pass percentage. In Class XII, **Rishwant Dev V** secured the position of school topper with an outstanding score of 98.4%. **Surakiran A B** achieved the second position in the Science stream with 96.8%, while **Akshara S K** emerged as the topper in the Commerce stream with 87%.

In Class X, Amal Raj T J emerged as the school topper with a commendable score of 97%. Prarthana Vijay and Niranjana A secured the second position with 96.2%, followed by Devakiran S.S, who stood third with 95.4%.

CO-CURRICULAR AND EXTRA CURRICULAR ACHIEVEMENTS

Our school firmly believes in nurturing all-round development and our students actively participated in various interschool competitions, Sahodaya zonal and state competitions, quizzes, debates, science exhibitions and literary events bringing laurels to the institution at district, state and national levels.

Achievements in Sahodaya Zonal and State Competitions

At the zonal competitions of Desinganad Sahodaya held at Sree Buddha Engineering College, Pathanamthitta, 150 students participated in different categories and our school emerged as the first runner up in Cat I & Cat IV and overall second runner up.

At the State Sahodaya Competitions held at Labour India School, Marangattupally, Kottayam 100 students represented our school and Bhavani Baiju won third prize with A grade in Bharathanatyam.

Sports and Physical Education

Our students exhibited excellent sportsmanship and commendable achievements in athletics and team sports. Professional training was provided for interschool football, kabaddi, roller skating, and athletics by expert coaches and the school sports faculty.

The Annual Sports Meet was held on 31 October 2025 at Sreepadam Stadium, Attingal, inaugurated by Mr. Lijin, recipient of the Best Sports Coordinator Award (Government of Kerala, 2025).

The school football team won the **Desinganad Sahodaya Interschool Football Tournament**, with **Fahad S** being named the **Best Player of the Tournament** in Sahodaya and **Oxford Cup 2025**. The **Senior Girls' Kabaddi Team** and the **Boys' Doubles Badminton Team (J. M. Krishna & Arjun Manoj)** secured **First Runner-Up** positions in Sahodaya tournaments.

At the state level, **Nakshathra** and **Anjana Biju** (Class VI) won **Second Place** in the **Kerala State Soft Pony Ball Championship**. In roller skating, **Anaika S. Baiju** and **Anouka S. Baiju** (Class III A) won **Silver and Bronze medals**. **Theertha Rishi** (Class V) emerged as the **Individual Champion (Category II)** at the Sahodaya Interschool Sports Meet.

The internship is expected to be conducted during February or March. This program will offer our students valuable exposure, mentorship, and hands-on research experience in the field of innovation and technology.

The exhibition witnessed enthusiastic participation from reputed schools, institutions, and organisations including KIMS Hospital, Niyama Sabha museum, WWF India, UKF College of Engineering, and several others. Students showcased a wide range of innovative projects. The event was inaugurated by Dr. Suresh Babu, Head of ATRF, VSSC, and the Valedictory Ceremony was presided over by Dr. Jayaraju Madhavan, Principal, UKF College of Engineering. Our school emerged as the Overall Winner, with SN School, Vadakkevila as the First Runner-up.
